'Jah-Man's' filling station, owned by Mr Jiji was a major success resulting from an NDA-funded integrated development project. Mr Jiji runs a rural service station on one of the main dirt roads in the Vulamehlo area. In 2005 PPT provided a range of support including business skills training, mentorship, business planning support and a micro-grant.

Mr Jiji undertook the following activities with seed capital which was provided:

- ➤ He bought cages to keep the gas cylinders, and vital safety requirement.
- ➤ He increased the number of cylinders and is now provides gas 9kg &19kg gas tanks.
- He revamped his convenience shop.
- ➤ He painted the name name of the station in Rastafarian colours (red, green, yellow and black) and to the buildings.
